## National Defense and Hill Air Force Base:

My number one priority in the U.S. Congress is defending and promoting Hill Air Force Base and the other valuable military installations in Utah's First District – not just because they provide Utah jobs, but because they are critical to our national defense. The productivity and hard work of the men and women at Hill have made the base a key element of America's military might. I am grateful to have received a seat on the important House Armed Services Committee. As we enter another round of Base Realignment and Closures (BRAC) in 2005, I will do all I can to help Hill AFB defend itself as a valuable asset to Utah and the nation. I am glad the House passed recently H.R. 1588, the 2004 National Defense Authorization bill. Our committee worked for weeks on this legislation that provides substantial funding for personnel, readiness, bases, and weapons systems for all branches of the military. It is a step in the right direction for giving our fighting men and women the resources they need to continue to be the most-skilled and best-prepared military force in the world.

## Summary of his House service:

On January 7, 2003, Rob Bishop was sworn in as the new Congressman from Utah's First Congressional District, replacing the retiring Representative Jim Hansen. For his first term, he was appointed to serve on his top three choices for House Committees - the Armed Services Committee, the Resources Committee, and the Science Committee

all three of which handle critical issues for Utah's First District. In January 2005, Rob was sworn into a second term. He was subsequently appointed by the Speaker to serve on the powerful House Rules Committee, the legislative “gatekeeper” for all bills coming to the House floor.
